 - Copies of 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript OR a <u>signed</u> copy of 2021 Income Tax Return and All Schedules completed, AND All W2s (Student) AND
 - Completed 2023-2024 Independent Verification form AND
 - Submit a paper copy of the 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A paper copy of the 2023-2024 FAFSA is available under the "Forms → 2023-24" page at https://financialaid.ecu.edu/.
