According to the information you provided: You and your spouse filed your 2022 IRS income tax return as "Head of Household" and you appear to have been married in 2022. Please follow the **Student and Spouse** Instructions listed below.

Please review these rules from IRS Publication #501 to determine who can file a 2022 IRS form as "Head of Household."

You may be able to file as "head of household" if you meet ALL the following requirements:

- 1. You were separated or divorced on the last day of the year.
- 2. You paid more than half the cost of keeping up a home for the year.
- 3. A *qualifying person lived with you in the home for more than half the year (except for temporary absences such as attending school).

*A qualifying person is:

- 1. your child or grandchild who lived with you more than half the year and is single or is married but still someone you can claim as an exemption or
- 2. the tax filer's mother or father, if the taxpayer claims the mother/father as an exemption or
- 3. another relative who lives with the taxpayer more than half the year **and** the taxpayer claims the relative as an exemption

You are considered separated/divorced if you meet the following requirement:

1. Your spouse did not live in your home during the last 6 months of the tax year.

Student and Spouse Instructions:

If you and your spouse should not have filed your 2022 income tax returns as "Head of Household":

- 1. File an amended 2022 IRS income tax return.
- 2. Submit both of the following to our office:
 - a. A 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript (signature not required) OR a <u>signed</u> copy of the 2022 Income Tax Return and All Schedules completed; AND
 - b. A **signed** copy of the 2022 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return," that was filed with the IRS.

If you and your spouse meet the conditions for filing a 2022 IRS income tax return as "Head of Household":

- 1. Provide the requested information below.
- 2. Return this signed form to our office.
- 3. Both the student and spouse must sign this form.
